ORIENTATION PROGRAMME : Orientation Programme was organised from 4/10/10 to 7/10/10.Before the commencement of regular class work, Orientation Lectures were conducted for the students by the subject experts with a view to provide the students a holistic view of the subject matter to be studied within the particular subjects and specific requirements of teaching inputs for better understanding and assimilation.

DISPLAY YOUR TALENT PROGRAMME : "Display Your Talent Programme" was organized on 27/11/2010. The groups of talented students trainees identified were called upon to perform events at a short notice. Some students constitute the back bone of colorful and attractive variety programme to be presented on the occasion of the college annual day function. In this way the social and cultural aspect of the college is taken care of.

N.S.S Activities : The college has an approved NSS Unit since 1994.During the session 2010-2011,NSS Camp was held form 11-03-2011 at village Chak-Avtara, Tehsil Bishnah. In addition to that, following activities were undertaken as a part of NSS programme:

Slogan writing and poster making competition on World Aids Day" was held on 1 -12-2010, wherein 30 students participated in this event.

During the camp, various surveys were conducted and the data were collected regarding number of persons in the family, literacy level, socio-economic status, cleanliness, road Connectivity and prevalence of communicable diseases. Local population was educated about the benefits of Yoga on 15-03-11 by NSS volunteers.

NSS Valedictory function was held on 11-034-2010 in the village Chak Avtara where in Gambir Dev Singh Charak, Managing Director, Dogra Hr.Sec. School was the chief guest of the occassion. The camp was organized successfully under the able guidance of Mrs.Rajni Manhas, NSS Programme Officer. On the same very day, a Plant drive was also held at village Chak Avtara.

PEER TEACHING: Peer Teaching is also the regular feature of academic activities of the college where in one of the members of the peer group plays the role of the teacher and rest of the members of the peer group act as the classroom students. Peer Teaching was organized from 26-03-2011 to 30-03-2011.

GAMES AND SPORTS: Besides developing the mental ability of the students, the college takes special care of their physical fitness and recreation. In this regard a Sports Week was also organized in the college premises. The sports meet was inaugurated by the Kr. Samardev Singh Charak, Secretary Dogra Educational Trust.
