Q.1:

- Demand : demand refers to desire for a commodity with sufficient level of money and willingness of a spender.

it comprises of three component :

- desire for a commodity
- sufficient level of money
- willingness of a spender.

Law of demand : this law states that there is negative and inverse relationship between the price and quantity demanded.

- According to Alfred Marshall : "keeping all the factors constant, quantity demanded increases with fall in price and decreases with rise in price."

Assumption

1. Price of given commodity should remain constant
2. Price of related goods (complementary and substitutes) should remain same.
3. Income of the consumer should remain same.
4. Taste and Preferences should remain same.
5. Future Expectations should not change.

Schedule

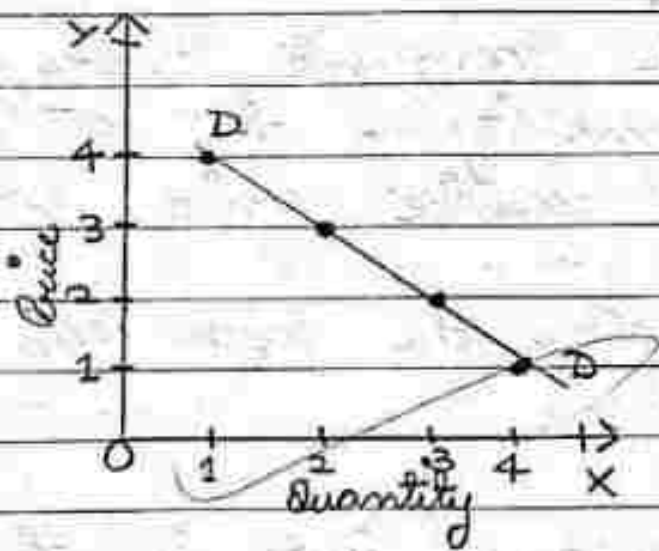
- It is the tabular representation of quantity demanded at different level of price during a given period.

Price	Quantity

→ Here with decrease in price of good the quantity demanded increases indicating negative relationship.

Curve

- It refers to graphical representation of demand schedule.



x axis \rightarrow Quantity
y axis \rightarrow Price

DD = Demand Curve

- \rightarrow In the above diagram, the demand curve slopes downwards as at price 4 the quantity demanded is 1 and continuing at the least price i.e. at 1 the quantity demanded is highest i.e. 4.

Reasons for downward sloping of demand curve:

1. Law of diminishing marginal utility: this is one of the important reason for downward slope of demand curve.
 - This law states as we consume more and more units of commodity, the utility derived from each successive unit keeps on decreasing.
 - eg: consumption of tea after the fourth cup decreases satisfaction level.
2. Substitute effect: this means that if the price of given commodity increases the demand for the related good will increase.
 - for eg: in case of tea and coffee.
- 3- Different uses: goods with different uses, with the increase in price is only used for the important purpose.

4. Income effect: this also affects the slope of demand curve as the income level increases with the fall in the price of a commodity. So, income of consumer is in relation with the price of the good.

5. Addition of new customers: when the price of a commodity falls, new customers are added as their purchasing power increases.

5. Taste and Preference: it plays a pivotal role as rational man will buy goods according to the taste and preferences [Determinant]

6. Future Expectations: If there is chances of increase in price of a commodity, the demand will increase in present and vice-versa. [Determinant]

Demand curve can slope upwards from left to right only in the cases of exceptions.

1. Giffen Goods: these are a kind of inferior goods whose demand rises and falls with the rise and fall of price respectively.
eg: sugar and Bajra
2. Veblen goods: these are the luxurious items which has no change on demand with respect to price or rather has direct relationship.
eg: diamonds
3. Ignorance: this means that people are ignorant or are not aware of the price of good (cheap) and purchases goods at higher prices.

4. Habits : In these situation even though price increase the demand for the same commodity increases due to habitual nature of man.
eg: Liquor

So, above mentioned are those where demand and price shows direct relationship.

Ans 1: Demand: it refers to desire for a commodity with sufficient level of money and willingness of a spender.

It comprises of three factors :

- desire for a commodity
- sufficient level of money
- willingness of a spender.

Demand Function

- It refers to the functional relationship between the demand and the factors affecting it.

a. Individual Demand Function (Determinants)

- It shows the functional relation between the demand by individual and factors affected it.

b. Market demand

It shows functional relationship between demand at market level and factors affecting it.

→ Individual Demand

$$D_x = f(P_x, P_r, Y, T, F)$$

P_x = Price of given commodity

P_r = Price of related goods

Y = Income of the consumer

T = Taste and Preference

F = Future expectations

a. Price of given commodity : price of given commodity shows negative and inverse relationship with the quantity demanded.

As price of apple will rise, the demand for the same will fall.

b. Price of related commodity

i. Substitute goods

ii. Complementary goods

→ Substitute goods: are when demand of given commodity rises, it means there must be rise in the price of substitute goods.
for eg: tea and coffee.

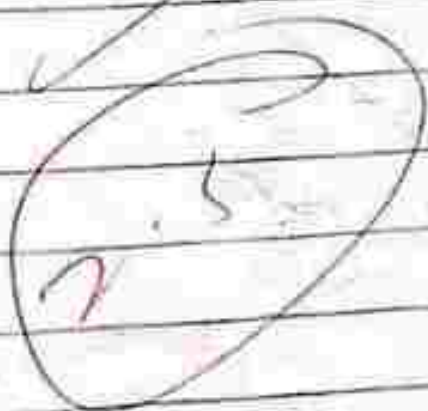
→ Complementary goods: when demand of given commodity rises, it shows there must be fall in price of complementary goods.
These are joint goods.
eg: tea and sugar.

c. Income of consumer: income, in relation to prices as price of good decreases results in increase in income status of consumer.

d. Taste and Preference: it directly affects the demand as consumer will prefer the goods which are favourable or supportive to him.

c. Future Expectations: If there is chances of rise in price of good in future its demand in present will increase.

So, these are the main determinants of individual demand.



Ans 2°

- Cost: It refers to the total expenditure incurred during the conversion of raw materials into finished goods.
- It is basically composed of explicit and implicit cost.

There are basically two approaches for the study of cost

- 1 - Traditional approach
- 2 - Modern approach.

- Traditional approach is further composed of Short run and Long Run.

- The main difference between short run and long run is that, in long run the producer has enough time to select factors of proportions

whereas in short run only one factor is changed keeping all others constant.

10. Total cost: It refers to total cost (expenditure) incurred during the production

$$TC = P \times Q$$

2. Average Cost: it is derived by simply dividing total cost with the quantity of output.

$$AC = \frac{TC}{Q}$$

3. Marginal Cost: is derived as change in total cost with respect to change in quantity of output.

$$MC = \frac{\Delta TC}{\Delta Q}$$

Here, factors involved are fixed as well as variables.

Whereas,

1. Long Run Total Cost: here factors involved are only variable and there is no fixed factor.

- It starts from origin

2. Long Run Average Cost:

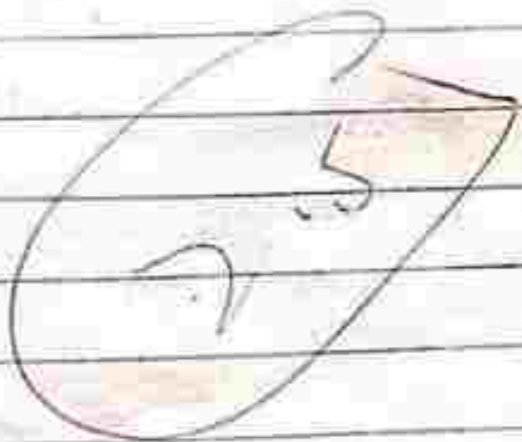
- It is also known as planning curve and Envelope curve.

As here enough time is there which results in maximum production at minimum cost.

And it encloses all short run curves in it.

- Long Run Marginal Cost : it is derived by dividing ^{change in} long run total cost with change in quantity demanded.

- Conclusion , In Short Run we have enough time fixed and variable factors are both fixed and variable, contradictory to this is Long Run Cost

Q1Ans A CHARACTER SKETCH OF ANTIGONE

'Antigone' is described as the heroine of the play; 'Sophocles Antigone'. Antigone is described as 'kind hearted, loving sister etc.' As she fought for her brother's funeral in the play. Here are some features of Antigone that is described in the play: →

- Loving Sister: → Antigone is described as the loving sister in the play, as she wants to bury her brother's funeral with every last ritual. She has the affection towards her brother (Polynices), she cannot see his brother's dead body for the food for animals. So, the love for his brother forced Antigone to do the funeral of his brother with

every ritual.

• Fearless ⇒ Although, by Blood Antigone is the sister of Ismene, but she doesn't have her nature like Ismene. As Antigone is fearless. (When in the start of the play when Antigone meets Ismene for the secret meeting at that time Antigone wants to bury his brother's dead (Polynice's) dead body exactly like the body of Etolus's is buried, but as Creon (King of Thebes) didn't want to bury Polynice's body and want to left his dead body for the food for animals, and declared the strict punishment on the burying of the dead body of Polynice, Ismene got scared and she denied the proposal of Antigone for the burying of the Polynice's dead body. And at that time Antigone alone went for the funeral of her brother's dead body. This incident shows that Antigone is fearless and bold in her nature.

• Kind Hearted \Rightarrow Antigone is also described as the Kind Hearted in nature. As she when she after the fight of the two brothers in Thebes, Creon declared that the brother of Antigone and Ismene i.e. Eteocles will bury finely with all rituals and other brother of these sisters i.e. Polynices will left as it is and his dead body will served as the food for animals. This scenario cannot be seen by Antigone. In other words Antigone is not able to see this disheartening or heart broken scenario. As both the brothers are same for Antigone. She cannot able to see this scenario because of her kind hearted nature.

• Affection towards family \Rightarrow After the death of their parents and brothers Antigone is almost broken at all. And even after the death of their brothers it declared by the King of Thebes (Creon) that

only the one of her brothers and the second will left as it is. ~~Antigone~~ will get the funeral. In the eyes of Creon it is not correct. She wants the equal justice for both of her brothers. She has the extreme affection towards her family and loved ones.

- Not Afraid of Death :- The most good feature of Antigone is that she is not afraid of death, even. As we already discuss that she is quite bold enough and fearless. As the Creon (the King of Thebes) already declared that he gave the hardest punishment to the person if anybody even try to steal the dead body of Polyneices. And without even afraid of death and not even thinking of her fiance Haemon, Antigone alone steal the dead body of her brother Polyneices and bury his funeral with all rituals. It shows that Antigone is not even afraid of death.

Conclusion \Rightarrow In the last it is clear that Antigone is overall, kind hearted, fearless, bold, loving sister, love towards family and loved ones and even not afraid of death etc. In the whole play, Antigone acts as a martyr, that how he steal his brother's dead body alone and went to the last gate and done the funeral of her brother Polynices. She even got engaged to Creon's son Haemon. And she didn't care of him also at all. She didn't even get scared or having any fear at the time, when she got caught by the guard or at the time of present in front of Creon. And when the Creon declare her punishment that now she will be killed by Creon as punishment. She didn't even care of it also at all. She with a wife, get presented in front of Creon and accept the punishment as well. Overall, Antigone is a described as a woman to salute in the play 'Sophocles' Antigone.
