(ASE FILE → MOND AHMAD KHAN v/s SHAH BANO BEGUM)

INTRODUCTION

→ It is a landmark law suit which has dealt with the problem of triple talaq. The case is normally mentioned as 'Shah Bano Case'. It is considered to be a very debatable and problematic legal matter in India. This lawsuit has substantiated to be a milestone in struggle of rights, freedom for women.

→ It is all about Shah Bano person and valiant struggle against the system of triple talaq. Instead of creating a history or tragedy of a suppressed woman she faced the compriments of the community and her husband. Even though she was facing a dire situation in her life she decided to struggle against her husband and above all bravely she decided to fight against the male dominated society. She fight against the system of triple talaq.

FACTS

- In 1932, Shah Bano was married of Mohd. Ahmad Khan, who was a renowned lawyer in Indore.
- They were the parents of 3 sons and 2 daughters.
- After 14 years of their marriage Shah Bano's husband married another woman who was younger than him.
- In 1975, when Shah Bano's age was of 65 years, she was disowned by her husband and was thrown out of their matrimonial home along with her children.
- In April 1978, she brought a appeal under section 125 code of criminal procedure, 1973 (Cr.P.C) in presence of judicial magistrate of Indore after she was thrown away from her matrimonial home by her husband.
- Shah Bano filed this suit in 1978 because her husband has abandoned her from the maintenance of Rs 100 per month which he guaranteed to give.
- A wife who is without any income and is neglected by her husband is entitled to maintain.
- Case which includes a divorced wife who is not remarried.

- In Nov 1978, he gave divorce to his wife Shah Bano by articulating or uttering Triple talaq and it is irrevocable.
- After he pronounce irrevocable triple talaq, he took a safeguard that since because of this divorce she has been terminated to be her legal wife and due to which he was not accountable to furnish her with maintenance of ordinary.
- Shah Bano made a plea to High Court of Madhya Pradesh to alter her alimony to Rs 17 per month.
- Shah Bano precedent went to Supreme Court and filed a petition against the verdict of Madhya Pradesh High Court.
- Her husband's essential argument after divorce he cannot keep any form of alimony or connection with his wife because it is not allowed by Islamic Law and is "Haram" and hence he is not legally entitled to maintain her wife.

Jussos Rissen In The Case

- (i) Whether Section 125 of CrPc is concerned with muslims or not.
- (ii) Whether the amount of Mahr given by the husband on divorce is adequate to get the husband and is liable to maintain his wife or not.
- (iii) Whether Uniform Civil Code applies to all religions or not.

JUDGEMENT

- (i) The verdict of Shah Bano Case was overruled by C.J. Chandrachud.
- (ii) On 2nd Feb 1981, Supreme Court gave a like minded conclusion in this case and overruled the plea of Mohd. Ahmad Khan and validate the verdict of High Court.
- (iii) According to Supreme Court this rule of Muslim law was against humanity or was wrong because here a divorced wife was not in condition to maintain herself.
- (iv) Court finally concluded that husband legal liability will come to an end of divorced wife is competent to maintain herself.

1. DEFINITION OF CHAMBER:-

A Judge's Private room or office wherein he or she hears motions signs papers and perform other tasks pertaining to his or her office when a session of the court, such as trial, is not being held is known as "chamber".

A chamber is basically a room or office used by an advocate or judge. An advocate chamber is a place where advocate chamber deals with his clients and listens to their grievances. It is a place where the details of the case and confidential communications are done.

In an advocates chamber, the files of the case are well maintained. A well maintained chamber or law office is one of the essential requisites to be a successful advocate. If the law office is systematically managed it adds to the efficiency and productivity of an advocate. If the law office is systematically managed it adds to the efficiency and productivity of an advocate. It is a place where a client can freely talk to the advocate without any disturbance.

2. Description of CHAMBER:-

(2)

The office where the advocate interacts with his clients and maintains the records of his case files is his chamber. A well managed office creates a healthy working atmosphere and can attract many clients. It is a large office equipped with books is a well furnished.

In the chamber the arrangement of chamber furniture is made in such a way that it makes the office tidy and it fits to the space of the office. Seating arrangements for the clients and staff have been provided. Also a waiting room with proper furniture as well and newspapers is made so that clients could wait there. All the necessary machinery is installed in the chamber.

3. Importance Of CHAMBER VISIT :-

There are great benefits of real-time practice in chambers. Chamber visit is basically designed for aspiring litigators and junior advocates. Such a practice of chamber visit helps you learn the essential skills and knowledge that you will have to pick up immediately upon commencing practice, including how to read and present cases (Judgements) how to communicate with clients and colleagues, the legal requirements of pleadings in civil and criminal proceedings, how to present factual and legal argument and much more.

We learn various things from chamber visit which are as follows:-

- a) Learn how to read a case file and how to carry out legal research specially for a litigation practice.
- b) Explore the major provisions of the Advocates Act, 1961 and Bar Council of India Rules, 1955.
- c) Learn how to effectively apply and present your research.

3. Details of Ownership :- At the end of the will, one has to mention who should own his/her assets and in what proportion. If one is giving the assets to a minor, he/she has to appoint a custodian of assets till the beneficiary attains the age of majority.

Brief statement of facts

May it please your lordship

1. That Mr. Ashok, a Hindu by religion married Miss Sanjana on 17th November 2011, as per hindu rituals, therefore they resided in the matrimonial home with the parents of Mr. Ashok. Mr. Ashok's mother was an orthodox female and had high belief in mythology and in hindu god. She had firm belief that to attain moksha, a man needs a son, therefore she always insisted on sanjana to conceive and give the privilege to them of being grand parents to a grandsons.
2. That Miss Sanjana delivered a baby girl on 9th april 2013 and there after differences arose between them. Ashok's mother continuously passed insulting remarks upon sanjana and her baby girl. She often remarks that if sanjana doesnot give these family a boy she will ask ashok to many time ashok to marry another girl. Several time ashok fought with his own mother telling her that he is satisfied with his wife and has no complaints from her. Sanjana started persuading ashok and move to a new house to which ashok never agreed. He was adamant that he wants to stay with his family.
3. That finally on 22nd December 2013, Sanjana frustrated with the constant bickering and in ability of her husband to change residence, decided to leave the matrimonial house with her daughter and returned to her parents house.
4. That ashok visited Sanjana house several time, however never found her at home. He could never even visit his daughter because Sanjana was never available. Finally, on 22 January 2016 Ashok frustrated with sanjana filed for divorce u/s 13 of the hindu marriage act alleging discretion by his wife. The summons was issued to sanjana at the address shown but the same returned by some Mr. Asha marked as "refused to accept". The family court considering it has good service proceeded with the matter.
5. That the petition was heard Ex- parte and on the basis of evidence adduced by ashok, the family court granted divorce to the husband on 16th September 2016. The copy of the order was sent by ashok to sanjana on the address provided.
6. That on 25th feb ashok married Miss pooja, a Hindu by religion. pooja conceived ashok's child and was due for delivery on 13th april 2018 meanwhile, Mrs. sanjana filed an application on 3rd oct 2017 before the high court for condonation of delay for filing appeal against the decree of family court granted ex-parte decree to ashok stating that she was unaware of the proceeding as the summons were served on the address on which she was not residing. She argued that she was frustrated with the constant remarks by ashok's mother and hence decided to leave the matrimonialised to sever the matrimonial bond.
